With Explorer Richard Wiese

Until now, the Polaris whaleboat, located in the Hercules Pavilion in Stony Brook Village, has long been thought to be the only surviving artifact from the Charles Hall expedition to the Arctic in 1870. Today, former Saint James native Richard Wiese, world explorer and author of the guide book *“Born to Explore: How to be a Backyard Adventurer”* shares additional artifacts from this 1870 expedition.
